

Manual

We encourage you to be creative with the use and expression of your very own sand dwelling.




In order for you to get going building it, there are certain elements that needs to be prepared and available.

00 — Materials

 <p>Box needed for fabrication. It can be a box you already own or downloaded through the provided file and fabricated at your local maker space.</p>	 <p>Biodegradable adhesive. The glue is designed to be broken down by bacteria. During this degradation process, they lead to the production of carbon dioxide, water and other natural gases.</p>	 <p>Seeds. A combination of pine, heather and neottia cordata is recommended for this environment.</p>	 <p>Water. It can be either found on-site or brought with you from home.</p>	 <p>Sand. The primary construction material. Found on site.</p>

01 — Prepare


If you have your own box, skip this step. A guide to assemble and disassemble the provided box box.

02 — Get it made






2. Thoroughly mix it.



1. Combine Sand, water, glue and seeds in the box.




3. Let it dry. Make sure that the mixture is completely dry before continuing.



4. Take out your new sand brick and repeat the process until you have the desired amount of bricks.


03 — Assemble




1. Draw out your nature dwelling in the sand. The one wall shelter just requires one line in the sand.
